LWV MACON NONPARTISAN POLICY

The LWV of Macon does not support or oppose any political party or any political candidate. The board has responsibility for maintaining the nonpartisanship of the League of Women Voters. The following members shall resign should they run for or hold elected political office or take an active and visible role in a campaign for a political candidate: President, Vice President, Voter Service Chair and Membership Chair.

Other board members who plan to engage in active and visible political activity shall notify the board. She/he shall resign if the Executive Committee of the Board decides that the activity would affect the community's perception of the League's nonpartisanship.

The political activities of a spouse or household relative of a board member shall be considered as separate and distinct from the activities of the board member.
